Danville Master Plan

The DBA has been sponsoring and collaborating with the Pennsylvania State University (PSU) Department of Landscape Architecture for the past five months, and will continue for the next three months, to develop a landscape master plan for downtown Danville.

Over the course of the spring semester, PSU faculty and eleven senior and graduate students in the landscape architecture program will visit Danville several times to develop alternative design plans that will have the potential to become future landscape projects in the downtown area.

Mural Project

The Danville Borough is one of five (5) communities selected statewide to receive financial support from the Pennsylvania Downtown Center (PDC) for a community enhancement project to be completed in downtown Danville this summer. The project will be a mural with a historical theme and is intended to memorialize individuals and events significant in the history and development of Danville and Montour County. The site selected will be in the riverfront district at the foot of Mill Street. Once completed, the mural will be visible to motorists, pedestrians and boaters passing along the riverfront area, and particularly those crossing the river into Danville from Riverside on the nearby route 54 bridge.

We are seeking volunteers to help with many aspects of this project, including artists. We must also provide adequate housing for the interns, which meets the following requirements: located within walking or biking distance to the project site, furnished and equipped with a bathroom, cooking facilities and basic utilities.
